AIM OF THE COURSE

The course is designed for consultant surgeons, general surgery senior trainees and theatre nurses with special interest in the laparoscopic approach for common bile duct stones. It aims to provide participants with the theoretical and practical basis for the initiation of a laparoscopic programme for the treatment of choledocholithiasis. The course will include aspects such as intraoperative cholangiography, intraoperative ultrasound, laser lithotripsy, use of transcystic and transcoledocal choledochoscopy, laparoscopic dissection and suture of the bile duct. Handling and optimal use of choledocoscope will be emphasised.

The course will be divided in three parts:

1. **Live retransmission** of a surgical intervention with the possibility of interaction between the surgical team and the participants.
2. **Theory**. The diagnostic and therapeutic protocols based on current evidence will be explained. The different management options for the patients with choledocholithiasis and concomitant cholelithiasis will also be summarised.
3. **Real practice in a pelvitainer** with an animal model, including the use of intraoperative choledochoscopy and ultrasound, extraction of bile duct stones and laparoscopic choledocorraphy.




