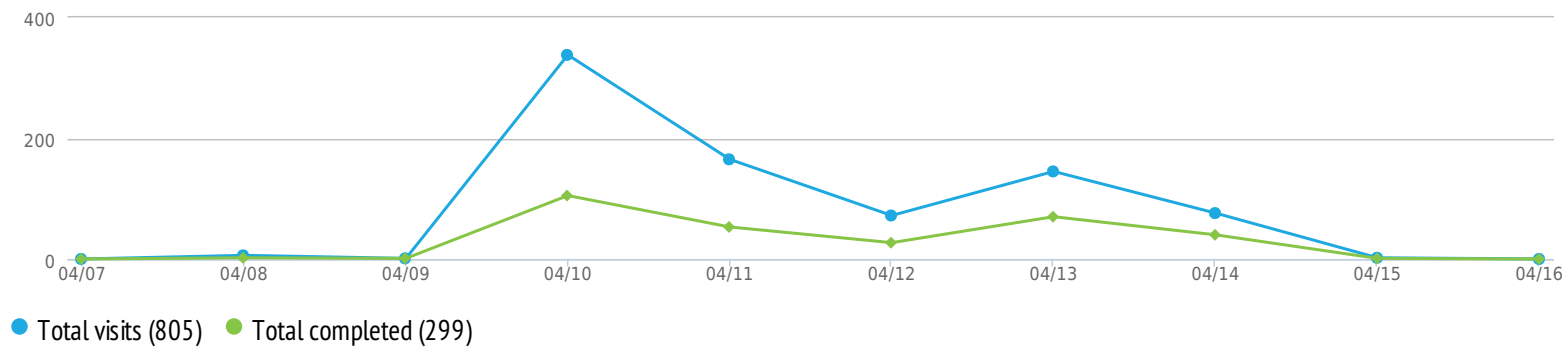

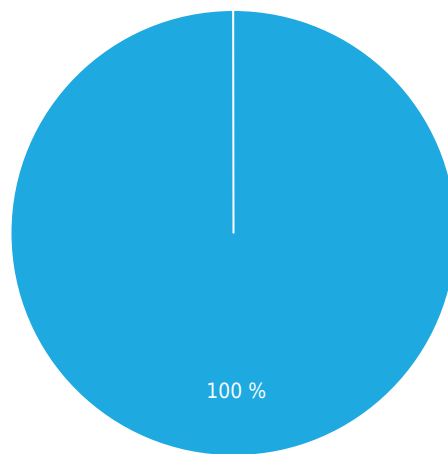

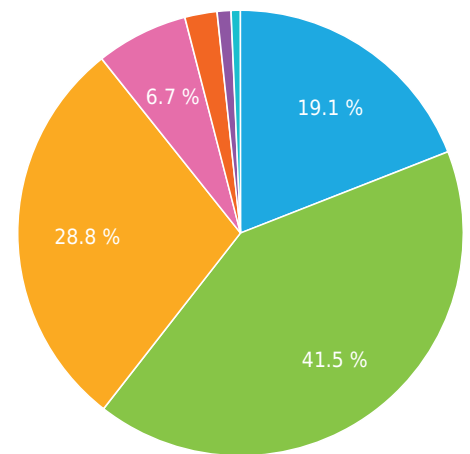
### Total Hits

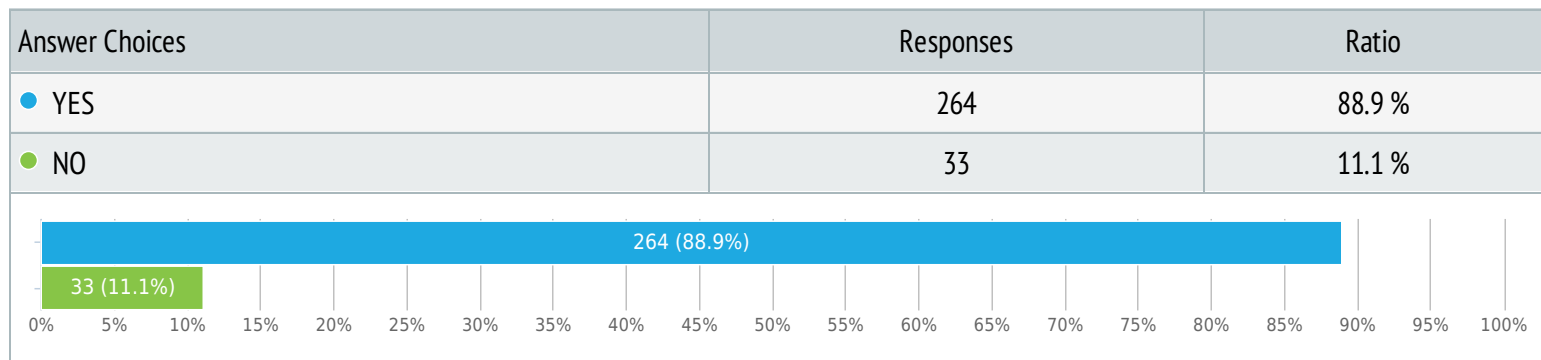

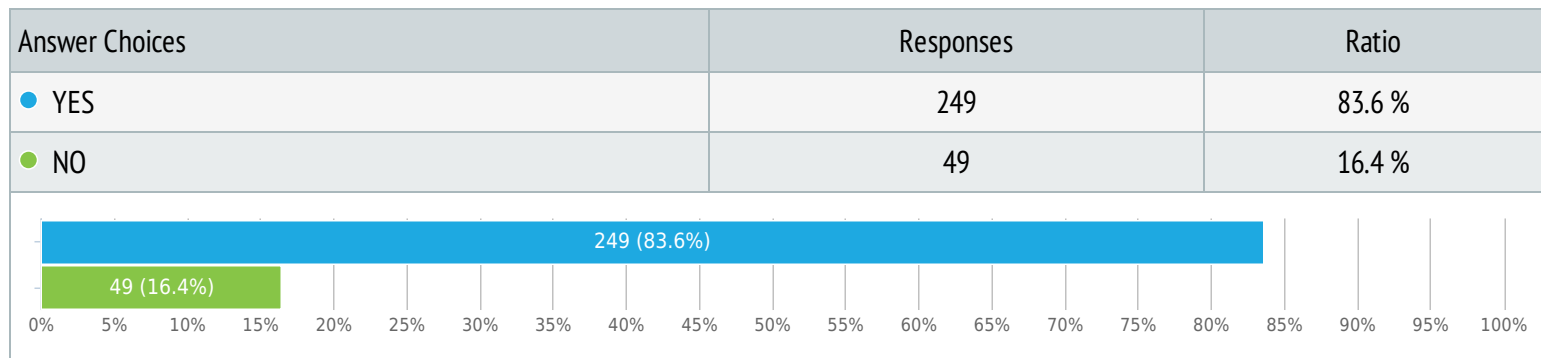

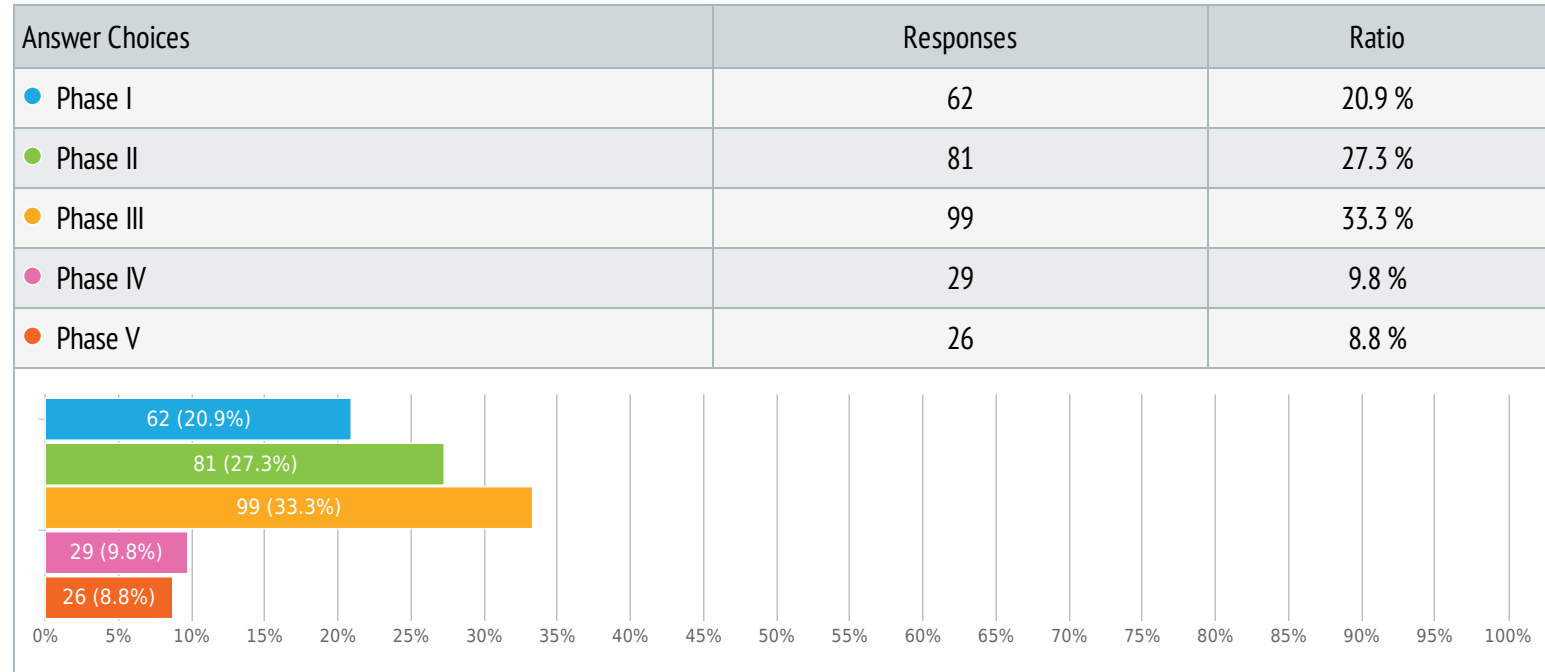
Do you think this Dynamic Scale reflects the different realities of our hospitals?

Single choice, answers 298x, unanswered 1x



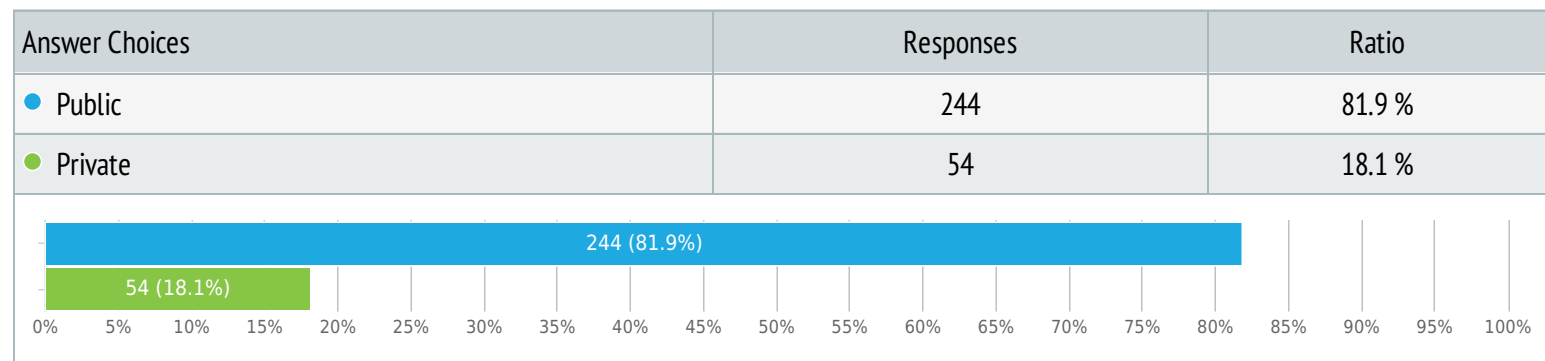
## What pase/scenario is your hospital facing right now?

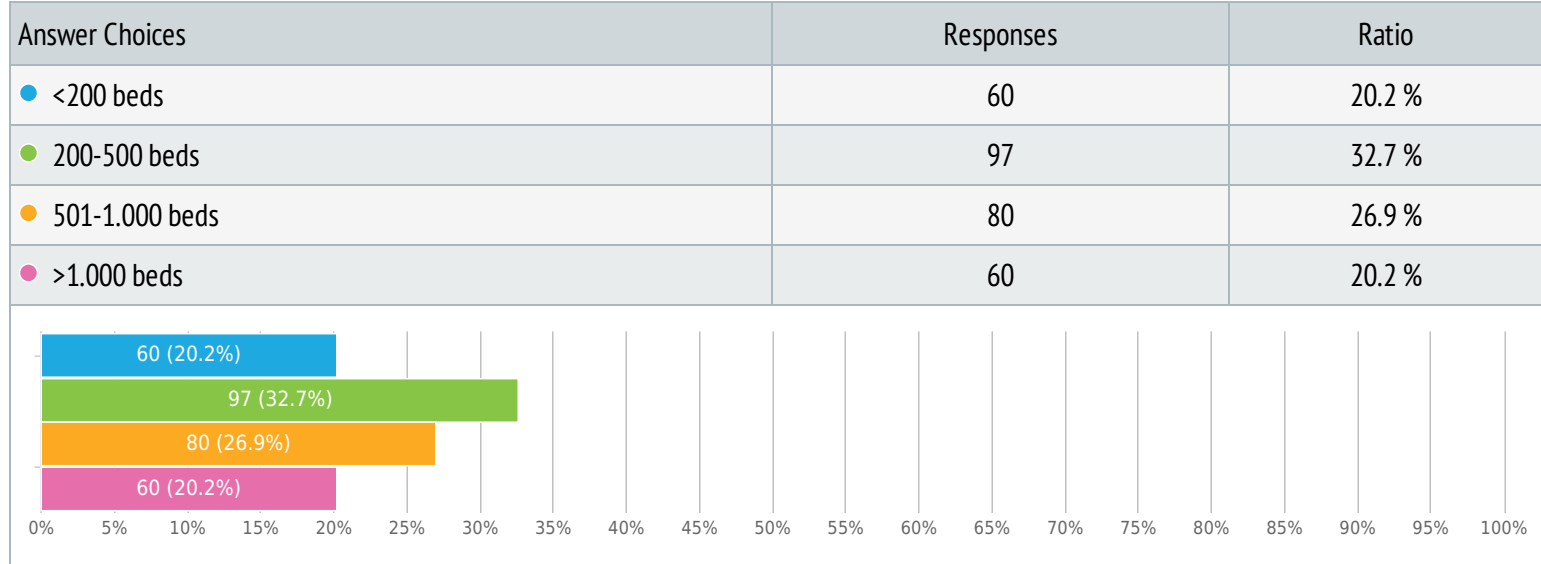
## Type of hospital

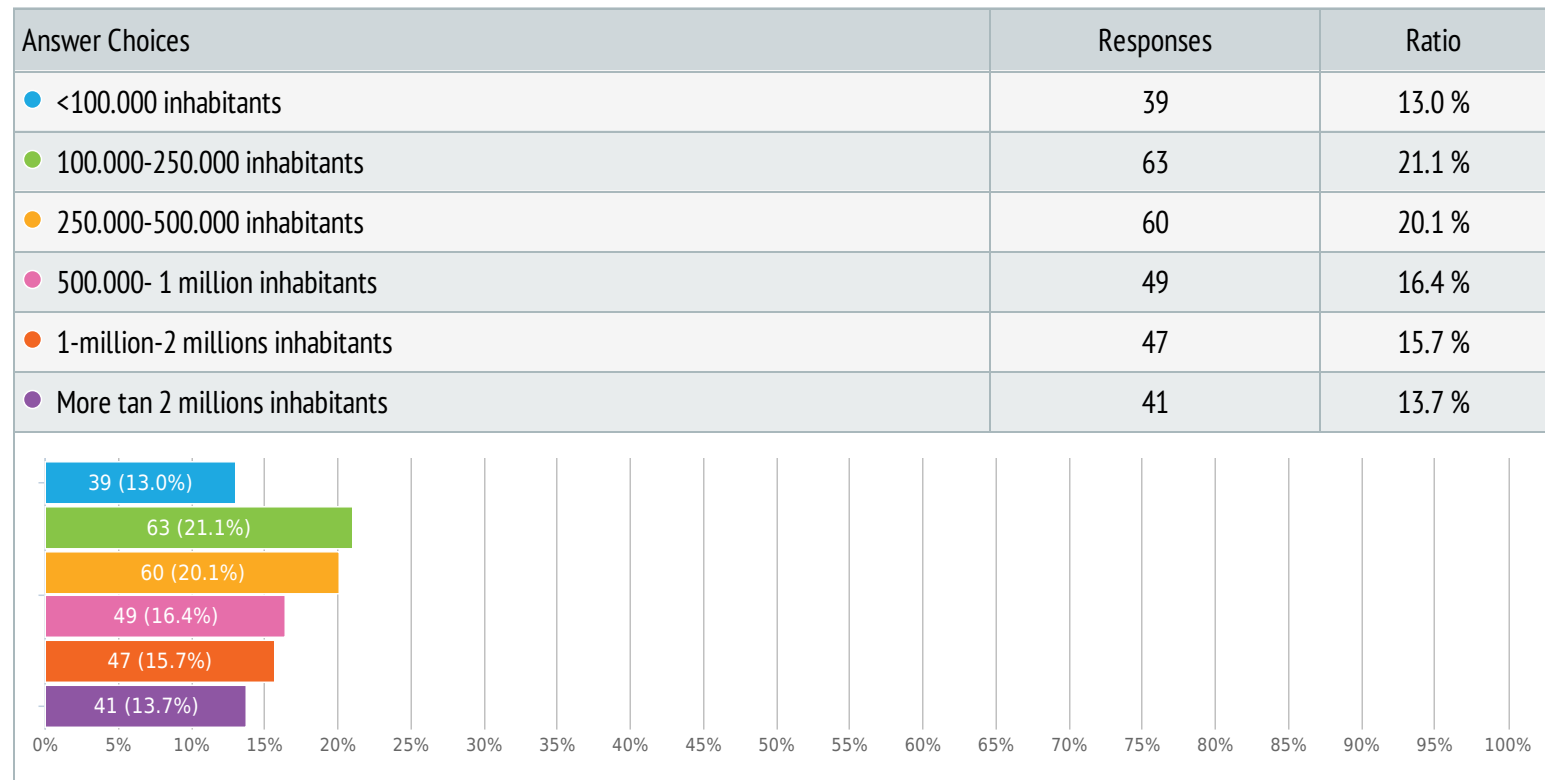

- My hospital is in Sant Pere de Ribes a district of Barcelona
- very tough situation
- We only have one or two elective theatre per week for oncologic patients. For emergency surgeries we discuss complex patients with Anesthesia and ICU before deciding the operation, mainly if the patient needs long term admission in ICU with ventilation.
- I have no idea what this survey is about and which are the various phases
- Needs to consider "mixed" scenarios (covid and non-covid wards)
- I think no all surgical specialities follow such recommendations as oncological procedures are performed regardless of phase alter where we are
- Phase II under current form will harm many patients over the next months. As soon as a plateau in admissions is reached (which is now the case in most countries in EU), Hospitals should seek to enlarge their surgical activities and allow surgeries for clearly symptomatic patients with benign diseases or oncologic situations that may not be immediately life-threatening but for which the current phase III model will lead to worsened outcome compared to how it should be under normal circumstances. The current situation will be there for months and therefore all hospitals should create clear and separate pathways for COVID and non-COVID patients or even better hospitals being separated in 2 categories (COVID and non-COVID hospitals) so that non-COVID hospitals can provide normal care with adequate prior patient screening.
